

HOW CAN I DISCOVER THE WORLD WITH MY JOB?

With the *Baden-Württemberg-STIPENDIUM* for Vocationally Qualified People, the Baden-Württemberg Stiftung supports young people who want to develop their careers abroad.

You have mastered your training and already have your further path into professional life in mind? Then now is the right time to gain exciting experience in another country. You can do a company internship or continue your education at school – whether directly following your dual education or after a few years of professional experience. With the scholarship, we support you in spending some time abroad. The stay abroad should serve your professional development and be directly related to the profession you have learned.

Young professionals from abroad can also apply for the *Baden-Württemberg-STIPENDIUM*. Thanks to the financial support, you will have the opportunity to get to know the working world in Baden-Württemberg. The requirements for participation in the programme are a completed vocational training or another corresponding qualification and special school achievements.

WHAT REQUIREMENTS DO YOU HAVE TO MEET?

No matter in which industry you work, you can receive a *Baden-Württemberg-STIPENDIUM* if you live abroad and want to deepen your professional skills in Baden-Württemberg.

You can apply if you

- ▶ completed a dual, non-academic training or a full-school education and have at least one year of professional experience,
- ▶ have good to very good credentials, and
- ▶ can provide meaningful references and qualifications.



THIS IS HOW WE SUPPORT YOU

Depending on the destination country, you will receive for your time abroad:

Amount of the Scholarship

- ▶ approximately 1.400 euros per month for travel and living expenses
- ▶ up to 500 euros for a language course

Duration of the Scholarship

- ▶ Internships: 2 to 6 months
- ▶ Further training: 2 to 11 months

To organise your stay abroad, you need to find an internship provider or an educational institution (e.g., a university) in the country of your choice. The *Baden-Württemberg-STIPENDIUM* team will be happy to advise you on this.

As a scholarship holder of the Baden-Württemberg Stiftung, we integrate you into a large international network. You will get to know people around the globe, exchange experiences and ideas, and make valuable contacts.
